About Dartball

Dartball is a game of darts played similar to baseball or softball. Two teams of 9 players face off by throwing darts underhanded at a dartboard 15 ft away. The dartboard is shaped like a baseball diamond with 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and Home bases. It also has spaces for Outs, Strikes, Balls, and Fouls. The dart is thrown at the board until you get a hit (by landing the dart in a base area) or by getting an out (by striking out, missing the board, or hitting an out area). This continues until 3 outs have occurred for that team, and then until 9 innings have been completed.
